The Municipal charter was elaborately stressed by the area MCA who pledged his support in the assembly on matter related to uplifting the Marsabit residents through municipality and any other development agenda.

Mr. Boru Diba, youth representative supported the move that municipality is a devolution tool where resources are channeled to the grass root. He explained that many areas have earlier benefited from the municipal government when Marsabit status remain a county council, he observed that devolution has proved to be savior for the northern counties who have remained marginalized by the subsequent government since independence. He however insisted youth and women to be considered in the appointment to the municipal board as well as any technical and manual work at the municipal.

The fear of raising the revenue and rates was explained that any changes will be based on finance bill which is subjected to public participation. After a lengthy deliberation on the matter the participants embraced the idea and asked for further enlightenment on any development agenda.
