

Mr Hussein Yassin agreed to occupy the stalls and urges the office of Municipality to take action to those who are not willing to occupy.

Mr Daigo Oche a stall owner also said they are in agreement with the office to take action in the case where the stall owner refuse to occupy the space.

Mr Wario, secretary to the Saku Modern market committee thanked the office of Municipality for being patient with the stall owners and giving enough time for three years since the launch of Municipality. He agreed with the other speakers and affirmed that the stall will be occupied and in any case the office to take the necessary action.

Mrs Galgalo also assured that they are ready to occupy the space and told the Marsabit Municipality not to persuade with the traders anymore and to terminate the agreement of the unwilling stall owners and give away to those requesting to start their business at the complex.

In response to their deliberation Mr Boru thanked the stall owners for their discussions and assured of their request to be considered and further announced that the stall owners who are offered at the market and fail to pay the revenue and not occupying the allocated space should consider the offer cancelled as they all agreed.
